The 8th Annual Pedal Thru The Pines, benefiting the Family Crisis Center, has rides for all levels and ages of cyclists. There will be 16-mile, 27-mile, 50-mile, & 65-mile loops, to provide both beautiful scenery and challenging terrain through Bastrop State Park and Bastrop's surrounding countryside. Cyclists will have SAG support and will be able to make frequent stops. Riders will start from Bastrop High School, 1614 Chambers Street, Bastrop, TX, 78602, at 9:00 A.M., and must clear the course by 4:00 P.M.

Registration:

Mail-in form must be **postmarked by February 24, 2010**, with \$35 fee. T-shirts will be guaranteed to the cyclists that register online or by mail postmarked by February 24, 2010. Remaining T-shirts will be distributed while supplies last. Register in person at Bastrop High School from 6:30-8:30 A.M. on ride day with \$40 fee.

Packet & T-shirt pickup will be at Bastrop High School between 6:30-8:30 A.M. on ride day and also available in Austin & Houston bike shops the week of the event. Please check the event website for location and times of early packet pickup.
